- written on section \$2 are the recorded deaths of possibly Carrell and Mary, and George, who seemed to have been saved from death
- a list birth dates of the nine children of Fielding Lucas Jr.

Folder 2 - Account Book B – Red, July 5 – Oct. 1, 184???

- recordings of groceries purchased
- groceries included mostly of butter, eggs, beer, and sugar

Folder 3 - Account Book C – 1916-1918 or 1919 ?

- “Baumgarten & Company Stationary, Printing” stamped in front pastedown
- Explosives Licenses from United State of America, Department of the Interior Bureau of Mines granted to:
 - Feb. 28, 1918 – W.J. Gilmore? Drug Co. in Pittsburgh
 - Mar. 11, 1918 – Wm. Davison & Co. in Baltimore
 - Copy of June 6, 1918 ? – James Baily & Son in Baltimore
- several pages balancing accounts of purchases from different companies and vendors

Folder 4 - Account Book D – Jan. 1, 1916 – Jan. 7, 1919

- “Day Book”- property of Cardine V. Davison ?
- Account Book E - June 1918 – Mar. 1939 (not in box)
- purchase of groceries
- groceries included mostly of butter, egg, cheese, crackers, crabs, bread
- other expanses included the laundry, poison, medicine, soap, Listerine, house cleaning, the Sun papers

Folder 5 - Account Book F – Mar. 1938 – Jan. 1940 ?

- confusing dates – perhaps book was closed on June 21, 1938 then reopen on Oct., 1938 ? – Jan. 1940 ?
- payments included laundry, the Cook, the Sun papers
- purchases of ice-cream, cheese cloth, soap, blankets

May have belonged to George A. Lucas

- This book may have belonged to John Carrell Lucas

- includes newspaper clipping with articles written on holidays such as Christmas, Easter, and Halloween.
- An Oct. 13, 1886 article on Mr. William F. Lucas, elected president of the Merchant's National Bank, in place of late Robert T. Baldwin.
