## A Kick-Off to Guitar Day Featuring Our Special Guest Artist and Presenter

**Ronald Pearl**, classical guitarist/composer, holds degrees from the San Francisco Conservatory of Music and the Peabody Institute. He has worked with guitarist Julian Gray giving concerts throughout the U.S., Canada, and England, releasing four highly acclaimed recordings on the Dorian label. Pearl has been a guest artist and given master classes and workshops at such venues as Yale University, the San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Stetson University's International Guitar Workshop, California State University's Summer Arts Festival, and the National Guitar Workshop. He is currently an Associate Professor at Loyola College in Maryland.
