

## **Before filling out the application form please read this important information about the PEABODY/HOMEWOOD DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM**

Carefully read *The Double Degree Dilemma* at [www.peabody.jhu.edu/doubledegree](http://www.peabody.jhu.edu/doubledegree). Applicants for the Double Degree Program come from the four distinct sources shown below. The rules are slightly different for each. The Krieger School of Arts and Sciences and the Whiting School of Engineering are located on the Homewood campus of Johns Hopkins University and are therefore referred to as Homewood.

**CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS** must apply to both schools independently. Follow each division's application procedures in the usual way. Submit a copy of the Double Degree Application form with each of your applications. You will receive results from both Peabody and Homewood around April 1.

**CURRENT PEABODY STUDENTS** wishing to apply to Homewood to enter the Double Degree Program may do so no later than their sophomore year at Peabody. Fill out the Double Degree Application form, submit one copy to the Peabody Admissions Office by the December 1 deadline, and submit another copy to the Homewood Admissions Office along with the Homewood application. *Please see the Double Degree Acceptance section below for important information.*

**CURRENT HOMEWOOD STUDENTS** wishing to apply to Peabody to enter the Double Degree Program may do so no later than their sophomore year at Homewood. Fill out the standard Peabody application form. Fill out the Double Degree Application form, submit one copy to the Homewood Admissions Office by the December 1 deadline, and submit another copy to the Peabody Admissions Office along with the Peabody application. *Please see the Double Degree Acceptance section below for more information.*

**CURRENT NON-JHU COLLEGE FRESHMAN OR SOPHOMORES WANTING TO TRANSFER TO THE PEABODY/HOMEWOOD DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM:** The application process is the same as for current high school seniors. While you should receive Peabody results by April 1, Homewood's transfer decisions are made later. You will probably have to wait until mid June to learn if you have been accepted at Homewood. *Please see the Double Degree Acceptance section below for more information.* By mid April the Peabody Admissions Office may be able to let you know the prospects for Double Degree Program acceptance in the event you are eventually accepted at Homewood.

**EARLY DECISION:** Double Degree Program acceptance cannot be determined until after the results are in from Peabody's February Audition Week. These results are sent by April 1. Thus, if you commit to being a Homewood student early in the admissions cycle, you will have to do so without knowing the Peabody results or the results of your Double Degree Program application.

### **Double Degree Acceptance**

Peabody looks for a maximum of five percent of its population to be Double Degree Program students. This translates to roughly 33 students spread over the five years of a typical program. We have more slots in some years than others, but there are always many more students accepted at both schools than can be accommodated. Thus, in addition to being qualified, acceptance is a competitive process based on the numerical ratings noted by the Peabody faculty at your audition, on decisions made by the Admissions Office at Homewood, and on the results of a joint meeting between the two schools. For current Peabody students decisions are made using the audition rating generated when you entered. Contact the Admissions Office to get an indication of your likelihood of acceptance to the Double Degree if you are subsequently accepted at Homewood. The same is true for transfer students waiting for their Homewood results. Current Homewood students wishing to be considered for the Double Degree Program will audition at Peabody in February. The numerical results will be compared to those of other applicants for that year.
